People v. Meininger, No. 04PDJ019. 4/20/04. Attorney Regulation. The Presiding Disciplinary Judge approved the parties' Conditional Admission of Misconduct and suspended Respondent John A. Meininger, attorney registration number 06421, from the practice of law in the State of Colorado for a period of thirty days, all stayed upon successful completion of a one-year period of probation effective May 21, 2004. Due to financial and other difficulties over an extended period, Respondent failed to meet the requirements of C.R.C.P. 260.2(1) and (2). Respondent was required to complete 45 units of continuing legal education, 7 units of which must be devoted to legal or judicial ethics, during each applicable 3-year compliance period, which he failed to do in violation of Colo. R.P.C. 3.4(c). Respondent also commingled funds from his business, personal and COLTAF accounts and wrote checks from this account to pay personal obligations, in violation of Colo. R.P.C. 1.15(c), (c), (d), (f), and (g). Respondent was ordered to pay the costs incurred in this proceeding and comply with other conditions.
